

PROCLAMATION

Whereas, 1 in 3 women and girls experience physical or sexual violence in their lifetime, most frequently by an intimate partner; and Whereas, Worldwide, almost 750 million women and girls alive today were married before their 18th birthday; and

Whereas, 1 in 2 women killed worldwide were killed by their partners or family in 2012; while only 1 out of 20 men were killed under similar circumstances; and

Whereas, 71% of all human trafficking victims worldwide are women and girls, and 3 out of 4 of these women and girls are sexually exploited; and

Whereas, Violence against women is as serious a cause of death and incapacity among women of reproductive age as cancer, and a greater cause of ill health than traffic accidents and malaria combined; and

Whereas, The Town of Caledon raises awareness about woman abuse and acknowledges continued commitment to address woman abuse.

Therefore, I, Annette Groves, Mayor of the Town of Caledon, hereby do proclaim

November 25, 2025

as

"International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women"

in the Town of Caledon and do commend its thoughtful observance to all citizens of our municipality.
