Potential Policy Ideas

Policy Ideas to Consider

1. Can a policy be provided to ensure that only a licensed, experienced, blasting engineer be permitted to operate in Caledon? Can a license be mandatory?
2. Can a permanent onsite setback of 500 metres (equivalent of an excavation limit) be imposed on the quarry site?
3. Can a permanent offsite minimum separation distance of 1000 metres between the boundary limits of a quarry and settlement area, rural cluster, or sensitive land use (broadly defined)?
4. Can a noise and vibration by-law be passed by Council to restrict vibrations at boundary limits? Can the standard be lower (e.g., 2mm/s) than the Provincial standard?
